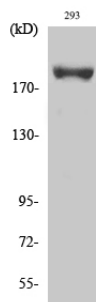

Storage Instructions	Store at -20°C for one year. For short term storage and frequent use, store at 4°C for up to one month. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

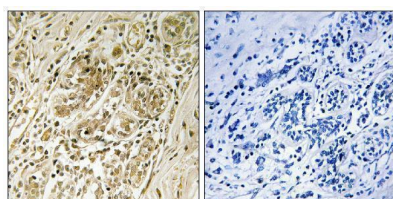

Immunogen	The antiserum was produced against synthesized peptide derived from human IRS-1 around the phosphorylation site of Ser639. AA range:605-654

Purification	The antibody was affinity-purified from rabbit antiserum by affinity-chromatography using epitope-specific immunogen.
