About EXO1

Exonuclease 1 is an enzyme that in humans is encoded by the EXO1 gene. It is mapped to 1q43. This gene encodes a protein with 5' to 3' exonuclease activity as well as an RNase H activity. It is similar to the *Saccharomyces cerevisiae* protein Exo1 which interacts with Msh2 and which is involved in mismatch repair and recombination. Alternative splicing of this gene results in three transcript variants encoding two different isoforms.
