### About TGFB111

Transforming growth factor beta-1-induced transcript 1 protein is a protein that in humans is encoded by the TGFB111 gene. This gene encodes a coactivator of the androgen receptor, a transcription factor which is activated by androgen and has a key role in male sexual differentiation. The encoded protein is thought to regulate androgen receptor activity and may have a role to play in the treatment of prostate cancer. Multiple transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been found for this gene.
