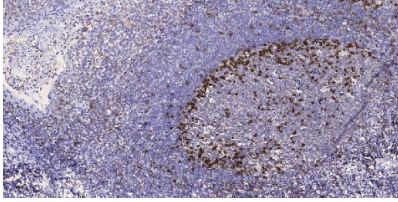

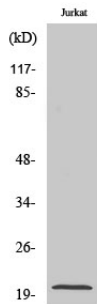

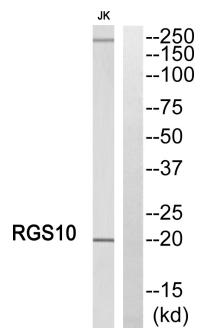
## Anti-RGS10 Antibody (A05197-1) Images
