About ENO3

Enolase 3 (ENO3), more commonly known as beta-enolase (ENO-beta), is an enzyme that in humans is encoded by the ENO3 gene. This gene encodes one of the three enolase isoenzymes found in mammals. This isoenzyme is found in skeletal muscle cells in the adult where it may play a role in muscle development and regeneration. A switch from alpha enolase to beta enolase occurs in muscle tissue during development in rodents. Mutations in this gene have been associated with glycogen storage disease. Alternatively spliced transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been described.
