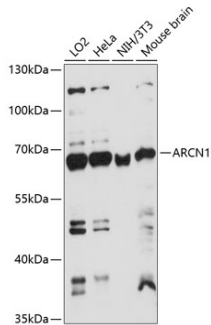

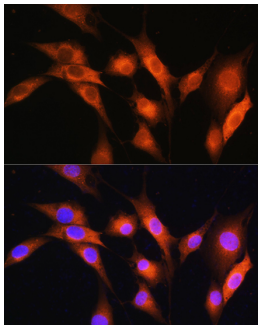

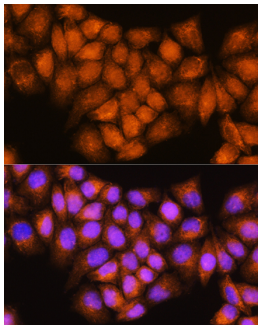
## Anti-Coatomer subunit delta ARCNI Antibody (A08725) Images
