About PPM1E

protein phosphatase, Mg²⁺/Mn²⁺ dependent 1E is a protein that in humans is encoded by the PPM1E gene. It is mapped to 17q22. This gene encodes a member of the PPM family of serine/threonine-protein phosphatases. The encoded protein is localized to the nucleus and dephosphorylates and inactivates multiple substrates including serine/threonine-protein kinase PAK 1, 5'-AMP-activated protein kinase (AMPK) and the multifunctional calcium/calmodulin-dependent protein kinases. Alternatively spliced transcript variants have been observed for this gene.
