Enables methylated histone binding activity and transcription corepressor binding activity. Predicted to be involved in several processes, including regulation of histone H3-K27 methylation; regulation of transcription by RNA polymerase II; and segment specification. Predicted to act upstream of or within cellular response to leukemia inhibitory factor. Located in cytoplasm; focal adhesion; and nucleoplasm.
