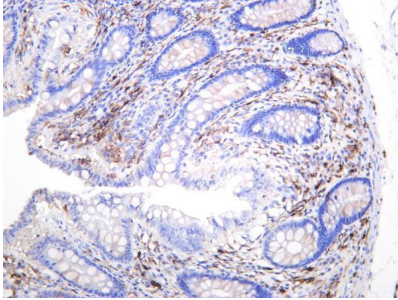

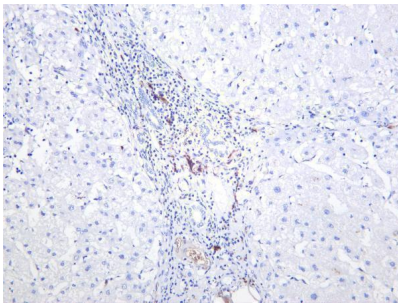

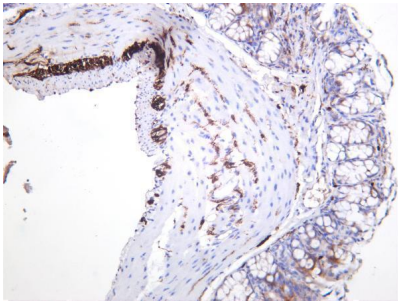

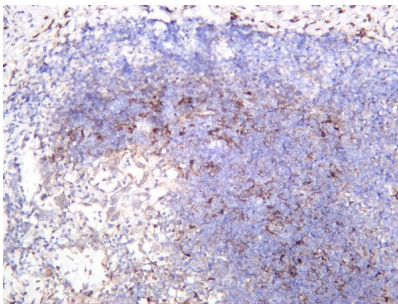
Human colon was stained with anti-S100B rabbit antibody



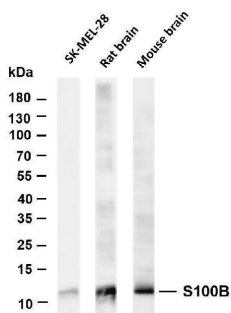
Human liver was stained with anti-S100B rabbit antibody
