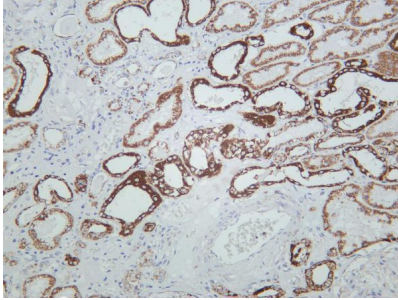

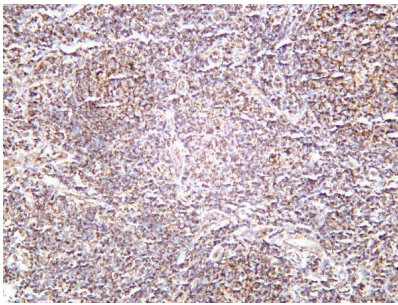

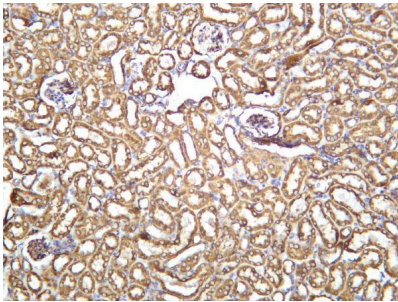

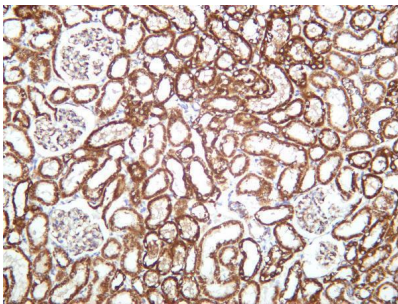
Human kidney was stained with anti-VDAC1 rabbit antibody



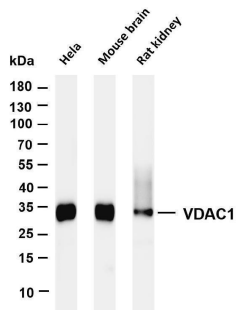
Human tonsil was stained with anti-VDAC1 rabbit antibody
