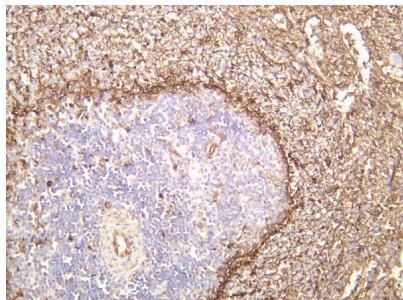

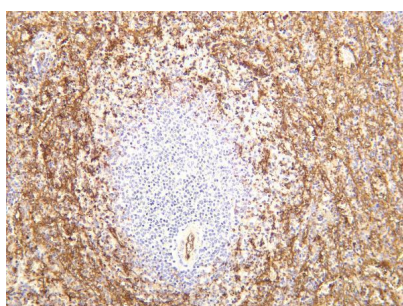

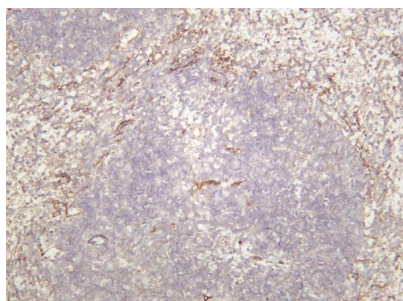

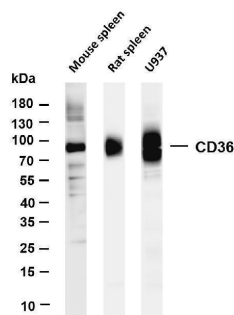
Rat spleen was stained with anti-CD36 rabbit antibody
