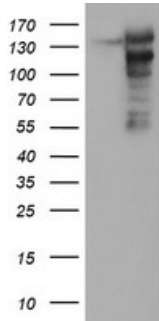

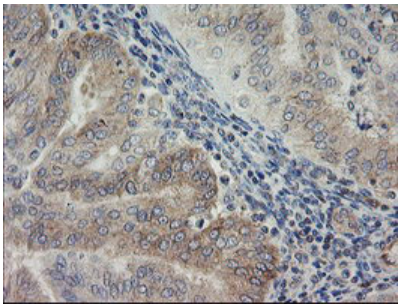

Suggested Dilutions	WB 1:4000 IHC 1:150

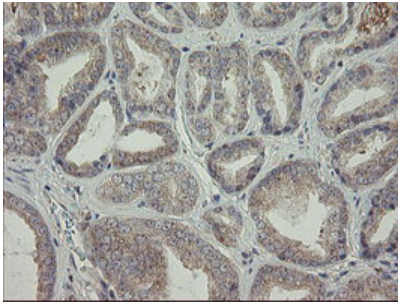
Anti-AGTPBP1 Mouse Monoclonal Antibody [Clone ID: OTI9A3] (M06334) Images



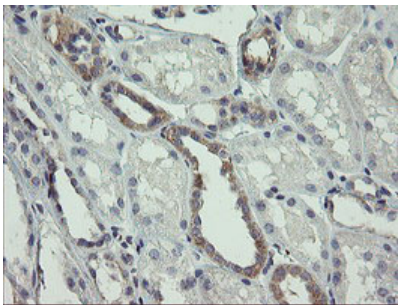
HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY AGTPBP1 (Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-AGTPBP1.



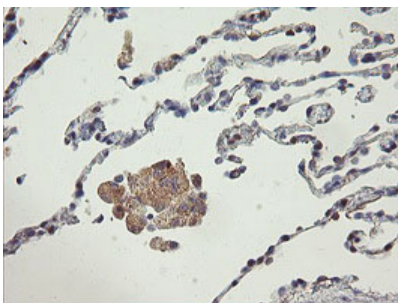
