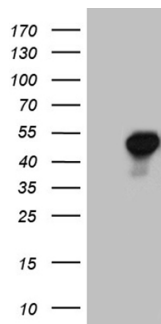

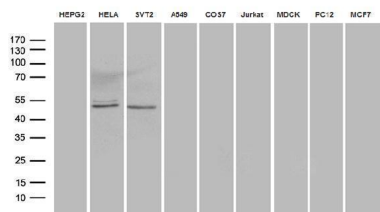

HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY AZIN1 (Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-AZIN1.



Western blot analysis of extracts (35ug) from 9 different cell lines by using anti-AZIN1 monoclonal antibody (1:500).
