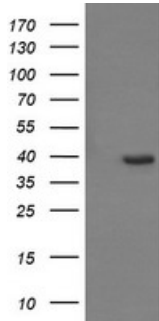

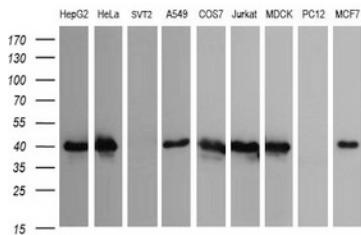

Immunogen	Full length human recombinant protein of human CDC123 (NP_006014) produced in HEK293T cell.
Isotype	IgG2a

Suggested Dilutions	WB 1:200~4000 IHC 1:150 IF 1:100

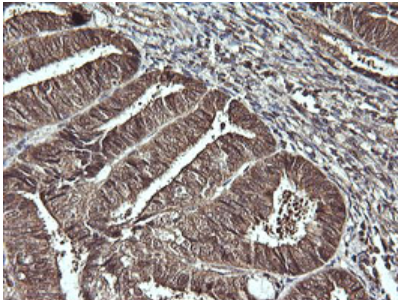
Anti-C10orf7 (CDC123) Mouse Monoclonal Antibody [Clone ID: OTI1F8] (M08251) Images



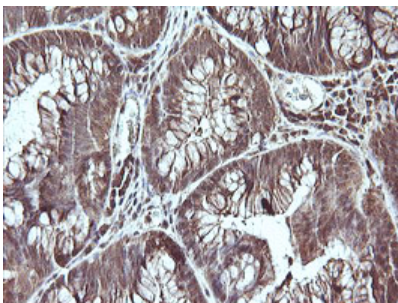
HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY CDC123 (Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-CDC123.



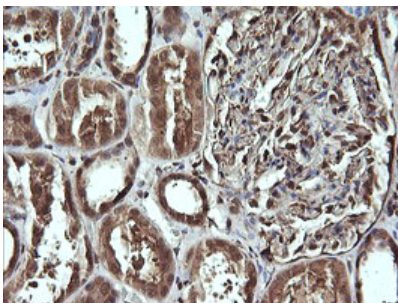

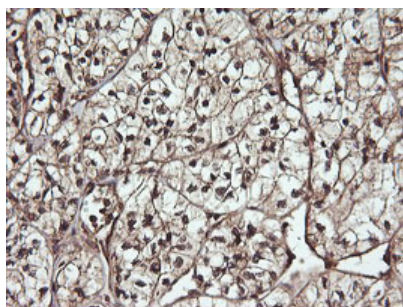

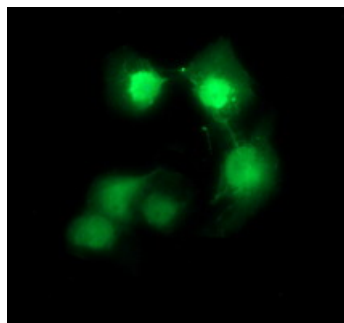

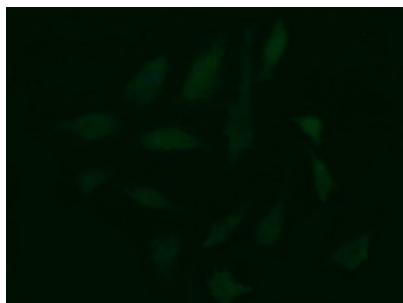
