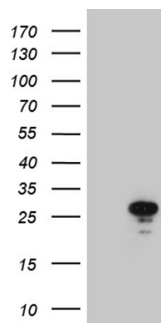

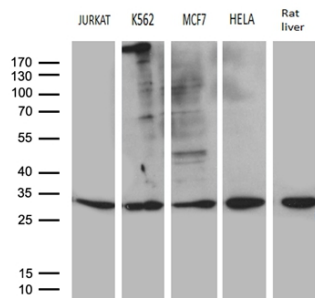

HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY MED19 (Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-MED19 (1:2000).



Western blot analysis of extracts (35ug) from 4 different cell lines and rat liver tissue lysate by using anti-MED19 monoclonal antibody (1:500).
