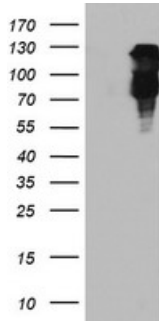

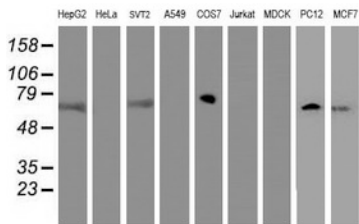

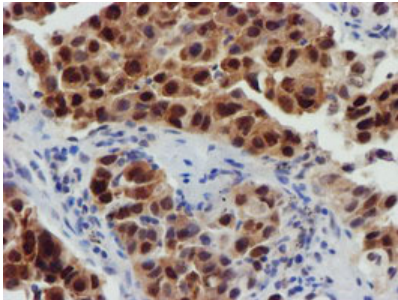
Anti-FBXO21 Mouse Monoclonal Antibody [Clone ID: OTI5H4] (M13227) Images



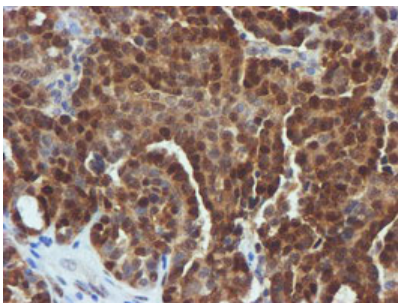
HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY FBXO21 (Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-FBXO21.



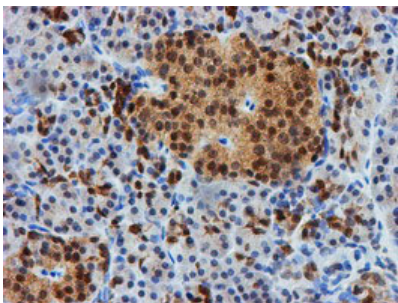
Western blot analysis of extracts (35ug) from 9 different cell lines by using anti-FBXO21 monoclonal antibody.



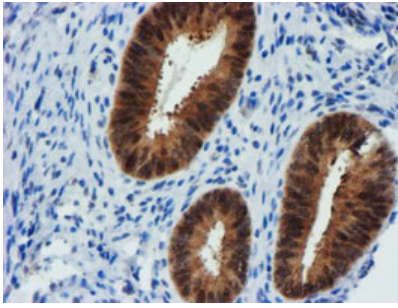

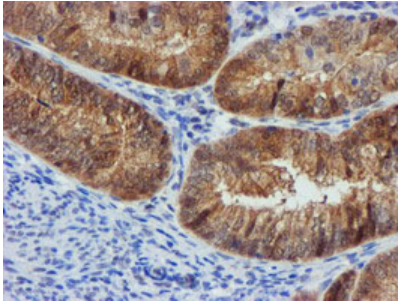

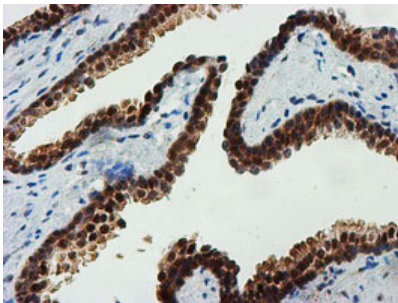

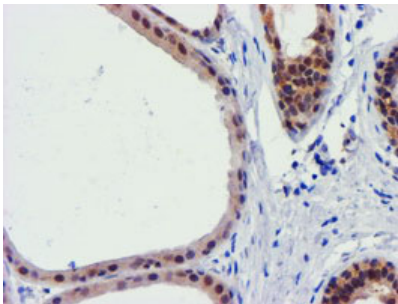

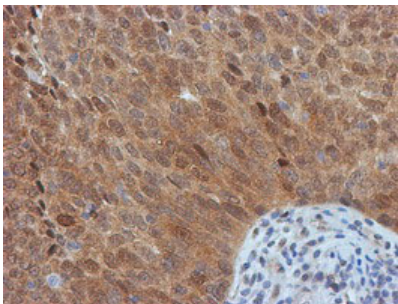

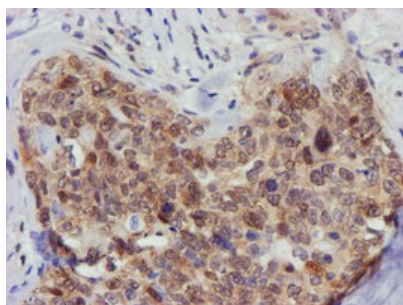

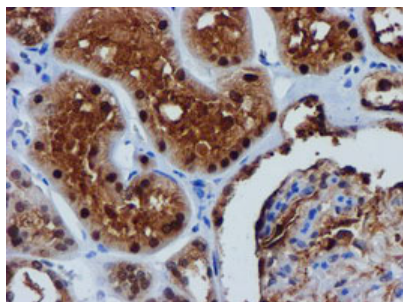

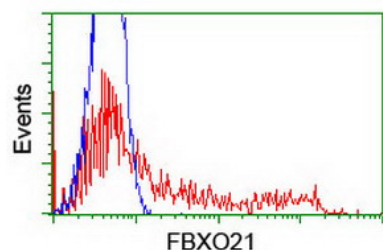
Immunohistochemical staining of paraffin-embedded Adenocarcinoma of Human breast tissue using anti-FBXO21



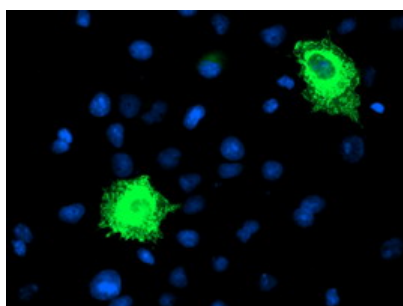
