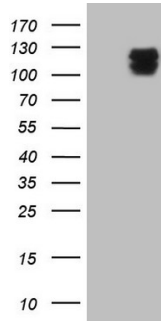

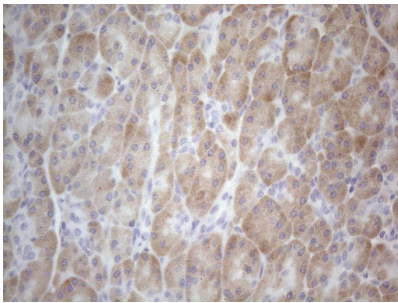

Immunogen	Human recombinant protein fragment corresponding to amino acids 429-770 of human TTC14 (NP_597719) produced in E.coli.
Isotype	IgG1

Purification	Purified from mouse ascites fluids or tissue culture supernatant by affinity chromatography (protein A/G)
Suggested Dilutions	WB 1:2000 IHC 1:150

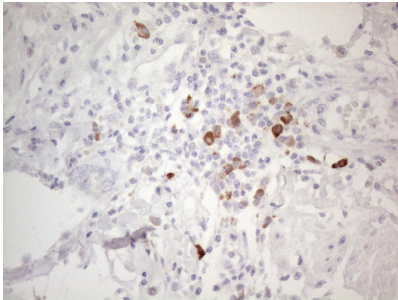
Anti-TTC14 Mouse Monoclonal Antibody [Clone ID: OTI9E11] (M14112) Images



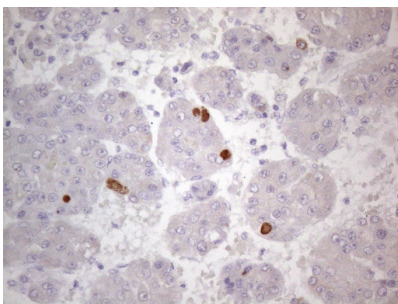
HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY TTC14 (Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-TTC14 (1:2000).



Immunohistochemical staining of paraffin-embedded Human pancreas tissue within the normal limits using anti-TTC14 mouse monoclonal antibody. (Heat-induced epitope retrieval by 1mM EDTA in 10mM Tris buffer (pH8.5) at 120°C for 3min)
