About HNF1B

HNF1 homeobox B (hepatocyte nuclear factor 1 homeobox B), also known as HNF1B or transcription factor 2 (TCF2), is a human gene. It is a member of the homeodomain-containing superfamily of transcription factors. This gene is mapped to 17q12. The HNF1B protein is believed to form heterodimers with another liver-specific member of this transcription factor family, TCF1. HNF1B functions as both a classic transcriptional activator and as a bookmarking factor that marks target genes for rapid transcriptional reactivation after mitosis. HNF1B also can regulate renal tubulogenesis by controlling expression of SOC3. Mutation of HNF1B that disrupts normal function has been identified as the cause of MODY5 (Maturity-Onset of Diabetes, Type 5).

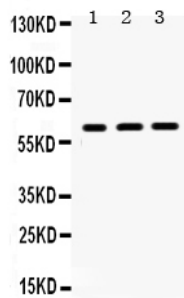

Formulation	Each vial contains antibody formulated with stabilizing components, 0.9 mg NaCl, 0.2 mg Na ₂ HPO ₄ , and 0.05 mg Na ₃ N. *This antibody is supplied in a stabilized formulation. Compatibility with conjugation reactions depends on the chemistry of the conjugation method used. For conjugation methods that are not compatible with the stabilizing components present in this formulation, a carrier-free antibody format is required.
Storage Instructions	Store at -20°C for one year from date of receipt. After reconstitution, at 4°C for one month. It can also be aliquotted and stored frozen at -20°C for six months. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Western blot analysis of HNF1 beta using anti-HNF1 beta antibody (PB9597). Electrophoresis was performed on a 5-20% SDS-PAGE gel at 70V (Stacking gel) / 90V (Resolving gel) for 2-3 hours. Lane 1: Rat Liver Tissue Lysate at 50ug, Lane 2: Rat Kidney Tissue Lysate at 50ug, Lane 3: SW620 Whole Cell Lysate at 40ug. After electrophoresis, proteins were transferred to a nitrocellulose membrane at 150 mA for 50-90 minutes. Blocked the membrane with 5% non-fat milk/TBS for 1.5 hour at RT. The membrane was incubated with rabbit anti-HNF1 beta antigen affinity purified polyclonal antibody (Catalog # PB9597) at 0.5 ug/mL overnight at 4°C, then washed with TBS-0.1%Tween 3 times with 5 minutes each and probed with a goat anti-rabbit IgG-HRP secondary antibody at a dilution of 1:5000 for 1.5 hour at RT. The signal is developed using an Enhanced Chemiluminescent detection (ECL) kit (Catalog # EK1002) with Tanon 5200 system. A specific band was detected for HNF1 beta at approximately 61 kDa. The expected band size for HNF1 beta is at 61 kDa.
